

Be Safe Around Trains

1. Stay Alert

Look both ways before crossing the tracks. Trains may come from either direction at any time. Take off your headphones. Put down your cell phone. Pay attention.

2. Stop for Red Lights

Flashing red lights mean a train is coming. Never walk around lowered crossing gates. DO NOT cross the tracks until the lights have stopped flashing and it's safe to do so.

3. Don't Take Shortcuts

The ONLY safe place to cross railroad tracks is at a designated pedestrian crossing. Look for railroad crossing signs or a gate to know where it's safe to cross.

Never walk, play, or take pictures on the tracks. Stay a safe distance away. Don't trespass on the railroad right of way.
